Pre And Post Entry Dates:

Entries open **April 13, 2010** for Australian Shepherds, and **April 20, 2010** for all other breeds – *no entries postmarked before these dates will be accepted*. Entries postmarked PRIOR to June 1, 2010 will pay the regular entry fees.

Entries, post marked June 1, 2010 or later pay the same as day of entries.

The entry limit per judge will be accepted in postmark order. In case of duplicate postmark entries, a random draw will be conducted to determine the order of acceptance. Each draw will entitle that dog to be entered in each of the classes available. If that class of stock is full, that dog's entry (for that class of stock) will be put on a waiting list in order of receipt. If an envelope, that is drawn has more than one dogs entries, each dog will compete for entry, separately, in the draw order.

Day of show entries will only be accepted if runs are available.

Changes and/or substitutions will not be allowed (other than natural division progressions or a same-owner substitution for a dog injured during these trials).

Entry fees will be refunded only when a dog has been certified by a licensed veterinarian as unable to compete due to sickness or due to an injury sustained during these trials. Owner will be responsible for all vet fees associated with the certification.

Trial Notes:

Run Order will be by draw, PRIOR to the trial

Bitches in season will run in draw order and must remain crated when not competing

All dogs must be on leash or crated when not competing

Awards:

High in Trial awards will be awarded to the highest single score in each class of livestock

Overall High in Trial Australian Shepherd

Overall High in Trial Other Breed

1st – 4th placements

Most Promising Started Australian Shepherd awarded to the started aussie with the highest combined score from all of the classes.

General Notes:

There is limited shade, please feel free to bring a pop up tent if you have one
Trial will run rain or shine
Coffee and tea will be available in the mornings
Lunches available for a reasonable price

As of January 2004, all non-registered Australian Shepherds and all other breeds, competing in ASCA for ASCA titles will need to have a tracking number. FMI: www.asca.org

From Toronto:

Take the 401 westbound. Take exit #208, Putnam Road. Go north on Putnam Road into the village of Putnam. In the village you will need to turn left and then make a quick right to stay on Putnam Road. Continuing north on Putnam Road you will pass under a railway bridge. Our road (Road 64) is the third road north of the bridge. Turn left onto Road 64. We are the first place on the left. Our 911 # is 642960

From Windsor/Detroit

Take the 401 eastbound. Take exit #208, Putnam Road. Go north on Putnam Road into the village of Putnam. In the village you will need to turn left and then make a quick right to stay on Putnam Road. Take the QEW Niagara from the Peace Bridge. Merge onto Red Hill Valley Parkway S via exit 88/89 toward Hamilton Airport. Red Hill Valley Parkway S becomes Lincoln M Alexander Parkway W. Take the Hwy 403 exit towards Brantford. Continue on Hwy 403 past Brantford to Hwy 401. Take the Hwy 401 west exit. Take Hwy 401 to exit #208, Putnam Road. Go north on Putnam Road into the village of Putnam. In the village you will need to turn left and then make a quick right to stay on Putnam Road. Continuing north on Putnam Road you will pass under a railway bridge. Our road (Road 64) is the third road north of the bridge. Turn left onto Road 64. We are the first place on the left.
