**Please Note:** Trial 2 on same stock as trial 1 may follow DIRECTLY after trial 1, and not after all the other stock of trial 1 has run. For example: Trial 1 sheep, followed by trial 2 sheep. While trial 2 sheep is going, trial 1 ducks is started, etc.

All ASCA® rules and regulations will be followed. Pre-entries will **OPEN** and be accepted with a postmark date of **March 22, 2010** and **CLOSE April 17, 2010**. Entry Forms must be completely filled out; one entry form per dog. In the event of duplicate postmark dates, a drawing will determine which entry will be accepted. Refunds will not be made after the closing date unless the entry is filled from a waiting list. Run orders determined by random draw in advance of the trial. Bitches in season will be allowed and run in the order drawn but must be crated when not competing. Substitutions will be allowed. Day of trial entries, if available, will be taken one half hour prior to Handlers meeting (7:00 A.M.) and will close when the trial begins. Entries cannot be changed after the trial begins with the exception of move ups. Divisions Offered: Advanced, Open, Started, Novice and Junior.  
**RIBBONS & AWARDS:** Ribbons awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place and qualifying score for each trial
