40 Duck & Cattle runs combined per day, 40 sheep runs per day
Courses (same both days): Ducks - B Cattle & Sheep - A
Divisions: Started, Open, Advanced, Novice, Jr. Handler, FEO

Awards: Rosettes 1st-4th

Each Day: High in Trial and High in Trial Junior Handler
Weekend: Highest Combined Australian Shepherd and High Combined Other Breed
Most Promising Started Aussie* & Most Promising Started Other Breed*

* To be eligible for Most Promising Started, dog must run in all 3 classes of stock both days in Started

Handlers Meeting for All Levels & Stock 7:00 am

Runs to beginning immediately following the handlers meeting. Class order Ducks, Cattle, Sheep – Advanced to Started. No arenas to run concurrently.

Run order to be drawn prior to trial. Bitches in season will be allowed to run in order drawn, but must be crated at vehicle while not competing. No refunds without a veterinarian letter; however, you may substitute any dog you own or co-own in its place.

Entry Fees: Ducks-\$25 per run, Sheep-\$35 per run, Cattle- \$45 per run

Day of Trial entries will be taken if space allows
Entries open June 15th and must be postmarked by July 16th

Attention to all owners of dogs NOT registered with ASCA

All non-registered ASCA dogs must have an ASCA Tracking number for any ASCA scores to be recorded and titles earned. If you want your scores recorded for ASCA titles and need a tracking number, forms are available at www.asca.org and will be available at the trial as well. There is a fee associated with obtaining a tracking number that is over and above your entries fees.

Important Information:

- Smoking in vehicles only!!!!
- Parking in designated areas only
- There is NO Shade so bring your own
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except while competing, no exceptions!
- Overnight camping is allowed without hookups. Contact Debbie Pollard to reserve a space. The closest motel accepting dogs is Motel 6 Vacaville - 107 Lawrence Dr Vacaville Ca (707) 447-5550 (less than 10 minutes away from trial site)
- Coffee & breakfast treats available in the morning, with cold drinks & water available all day. There is NO FOOD available on the grounds, but there are fast food restaurants in Dixon and Vacaville (both about 10 minutes away).
- There will be a “No Host Judges Dinner” at a local restaurant Saturday night. All are welcome to join us! More information will be provided at the trial.

Directions:

From Bay Area: 80 East to 505 North- Allendale Rd exit, Right on Allendale- 1 mile to trial site on Right. Look for Herding Trial sign.

From Sacramento Area: 80 West to Dixon Ave Exit -Right on Dixon Ave, 3 miles to Meridian, Right on Meridian, 4/10 mile to Allendale, Left on Allendale, 2/10 mile to Trial site on left. Look for Herding Trial sign.
