NOTICE

REFUNDS: Entry fees will not be returned if the dog's entry is pulled or withdrawn. Entry fees will not be returned if the show cannot be opened or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies or other events beyond the control of Lobo ASA. Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the Show Committee, ASCA, the Host, show veterinarian, Course Director, Livestock provider, or stockdog judge.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitutions are allowed by owner/handler.

MOVEUPS: No charge for move-ups. Move-ups are done during registration time only.

CLINIC: You may take a private lesson from any judge. Work can be done in any of the three arenas on regular trial work, farm trial work, ranch trial work, post advanced trial work, or problem solving particular training issues your or your dog may be incurring. If you wish to test your dog on stock, any judge can do this for you in the round pen area, and you'll receive a Certificate of Instinct Testing. **If you'd like to know how to improve your trial scores or your training and handling, here is a chance to pick the brains of ALL three stockdog judges. What an opportunity!**

AWARDS: Ribbons 1st through 4th; High in Trial ribbon, qualifying ribbons. No prizes.

HOLD HARMLESS: The Show Secretary, Show/Trial Committee, Members of LASA, and the owners of the host facility, Legends Three Pine Ranch & Australian Shepherds L.L.C., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by any exhibitor, handler, dog, property, child or spectator. This show & trial are being held on private property. You understand by your attendance and/or entry and entry that the Show/Trial Committee and Hosts have the right to refuse or excuse any entry or spectator for good cause. Good cause would be violation of the private property owners' rights or violation of the ASCA show rules.

TRIAL SITE: Legends Three Pine Ranch, 671 Langley Road, Estancia, NM 87016-8032, around 6600' altitude - tie tarps securely; no dumping on site; dress in layers (bring coats); use sunscreen; terrain can be uneven - dryland pastures; high desert

DIRECTIONS TO SITE:

► LEAVING ALBUQUERQUE/HEADING EAST:

From I-40 east of Albuquerque, get off in Tijeras and take 337. Head south, staying on 337 (about 37 miles) until it deadends into Highway 55. Turn left heading east. Watch for milemarker 89 on your righthand side (that is county road AO27/**Riley Road**). Turn right; it's a blacktop road. Go down until you come to the first dirt road that turns left; there is a cluster of mailboxes at the corner (Shope is not among them); this is AO32/Langley Road. Turn left onto AO-32, Langley Road. The ranch is the first entrance on your lefthand side.

► COMING FROM SOCORRO TOWARDS BELEN/HEADING NORTH:

From I-25 south of Albuquerque, take highway 60 to Mountainair. Turn left from Mountainair onto highway 55; watch for highway 542, turn right onto that highway. Then watch for county road AO27 (about milemarker). Turn left onto AO27/**Riley Road** (it starts out dirt and then goes to black top – you've passed Riley if you see Solomon Rd!) and follow it down to county road AO32. AO32, Langley Road is a dirt road to your right; watch for the cluster of mailboxes on the corner, turn right on AO32, Langley Road and the ranch is the first entrance you'll come to on your lefthand side.

► COMING FROM RATON/LAS VEGAS/GLORIETA/HEADING SOUTH:

From I-25 north of Santa Fe (bypassing Santa Fe & Albuquerque both), take highway 285 just outside of Glorieta. Then take the right fork onto highway 41. Follow highway 41 into Moriarty and then on into Estancia. At Estancia, go through the town to the end at which time you'll come to highway 55, turn right and follow it until you see AO30 (Ranchhouse Road)(it's before mile marker 89). Watch on your lefthand side for AO30; turn left onto AO30; it'll deadend into AO32 (no sign for the road). Turn right and the ranch is the first entrance you'll come to on your righthand side.

► COMING FROM CLOVIS ON HIGHWAY 60

Watch for the exit for highway 41 that goes into Estancia. Turn right onto highway 41. Just before you get to Estancia, you'll come to highway 55. Turn left onto highway 55. Follow it until you see AO30 (Ranchhouse Road)(it's before mile marker 89). Watch on your lefthand side for AO30; turn left onto AO30; it'll deadend into AO32 (no sign for the road). Turn right and the ranch is the first entrance you'll come to on your righthand side. If you pass AO30/Ranchhouse Road, you'll come to milemarker 89/Riley road, AO27 – follow instructions above for that road.

CAMPING ON SITE: \$15/night for electric (no sewer hookups - handicap get priority on electric); \$10/night for dry camping - water available to fill tanks - portapotty on site - camping fee will be collected by host upon your arrival. You'll need a reservation for any electric (it is limited).

NOTE:

- * Please keep all dogs on lead when not competing. Pick up after your dog.
- * Keep children and dogs back from the arenas; keep children & dogs quiet when a team is competing.
- * This trial site can have snakes (rattlers included). Call for the hosts if you encounter a snake.
- * There is no vet on site and no vet on call. A listing of vets is readily available on the bulletin board in the garage. Vets can be one-half to one hour away. Doctors are one-half to one hour away. Hospitals are one hour away. First aid is available at your discretion; you agree to hold harmless any individual aiding or giving first aid.
- * Please do not potty dogs on the tennis court. You may exercise dogs in the pasture area; please pick up after your dogs.
- * No dogs up at the main house or on the lawn areas.
- * No photographer on site. Win shots, however, may be coordinated with Stephanie Shope-McDaniel if you do not have a camera.

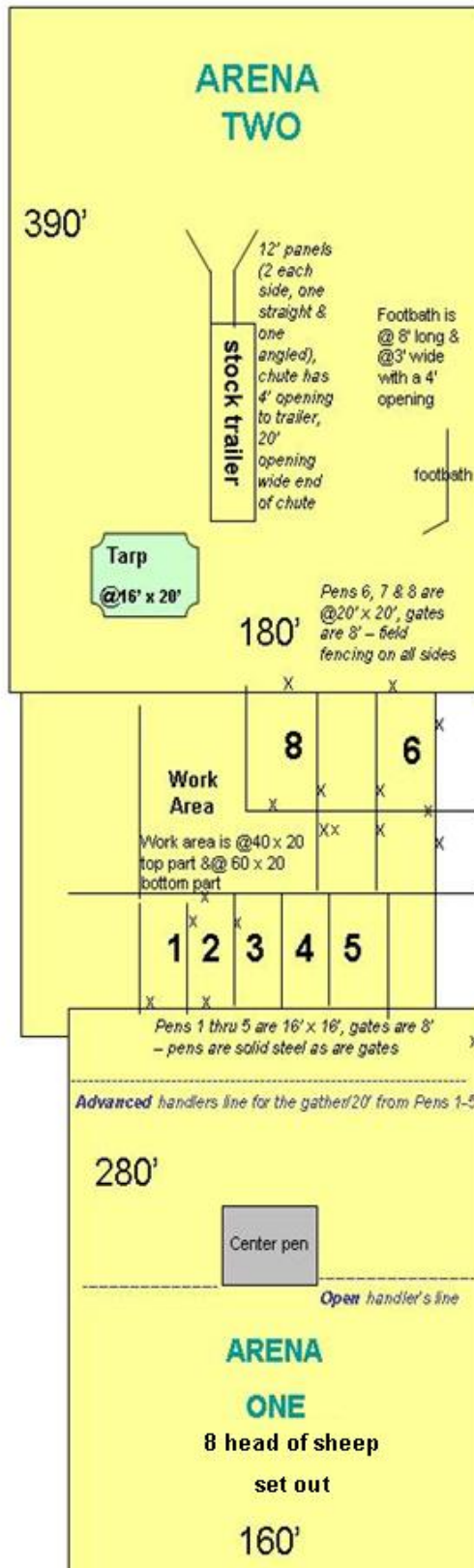

Time Allowed: 25 minutes

25 pts/Gather: Pick up all 8 head of stock. Open Handlers may walk even to, but not, past center pen on gather. Advanced Handlers may not go further than 20' from the pen area on gather. Colored markers on arena fence will remind handlers of their lines. Sheep are gathered to the take-pen area.

25 pts/Sort: Take gathered sheep and place them in the center pen in Arena One. Sort out the 3 marked sheep. Move these 3 sheep to Pen 1. Return and take remaining 5 unmarked sheep and place in Pen 2. From Pen 2, move these sheep to Pen #6 via any holding areas of your choice.

15 pts/Task #1: Take your 5 sheep to Arena 2 via Pen 6. Move these sheep through the Footbath. Do Not let your dog go through the footbath!

25 pts./Chute Work: Take your five head of sheep and load them into the stock trailer. Advanced handlers may NOT enter the trailer.

15 pts/Task #2: Place all five sheep collectively on the tarp for a minimum of 30 seconds. Advanced Handlers may NOT step on the tarp.

25 pts./Pen Work: Take your 5 sheep and place them in Pen #6. Take them through Pen 8 and into Pen 2 and then into Pen 1. Take all 8 sheep now in Pen 1 and put them in Pen Five via Arena One. You are done when all sheep are in Pen Five and the gate has been closed.

Warning Times: after 15 minutes have elapsed (10 minute warming) and after 22 minutes have elapsed (3 minute warming).

Tie-Breaking: The score used for the Footbath. If still tied, the score used for the Tarp. If still tied, the score used for the Chute work.

X marks where gates are located you might be using

SHEEP ON HAND are 25 head. Runs are limited to 9 entries. If more sheep become available, we may amend the sanction to allow more entries.
