NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

This is an ASCA sanctioned event and will be judged and run by the Stockdog Trial rules of the Australian Shepherd Club of America. Dogs should be leashed except when trialing and must be brought into the arena on leash. Entries will be accepted on a first-come basis and must be on an ASCA entry form. Drawing for run order will be done on the day of the trial and posted. In ASCA all dogs must start trialing in the Started Class. No electrical and/or mechanical training devices are allowed on the trial grounds. Bitches in season run last. Any questions, problems, or conflicts should be brought to the Course Director immediately. The Stockdog Trial Committee is authorized to request that any dog which, in the committee's opinion, represents a hazard to persons, dogs, or property by removed from the premises. Children must be kept under direct supervision of an adult at all times.

Jackpot is a time and points event. The Total Jackpot is \$2000. The Jackpot is divided between Aussies and Other Breeds. The rules and courses will be explained at the Calcutta Saturday afternoon. Buy ins are available for dogs entered into the Arena Trials on Friday and Saturday.

DIRECTIONS:

The trial will be at the home of Mark and Marsha Westerman just north of Whitesboro, Texas. Whitesboro is located north of Denton, Texas, between Interstate 35 and Highway 75. If coming from Interstate 35 take exit Highway 82 going east (17 miles). If coming from Highway 75 take exit Highway 82 going west (20 miles). Exit from Highway 82 onto Highway 377 (Pizza Hut / Dairy Queen) and go north 9/10 mile to Bones Chapel Road. Then go West ¼ mile to the first red barn on the left. Go to the office in the SW Corner of the red barn and ask for parking directions and the entry forms. If its wet, please stay on the gravel or asphalt parking. If in doubt, please ask where to park.

JACKPOT: \$2,000

To be run in the Cattle and Started Sheep arenas - B course. Winners on faults and ties will be broken by time.

4 payments, not evenly divided: 1st & 2nd Aussies 1st & 2nd Other Breed

Note: If you are wanting to complete in the Jackpot, please tell us at check in on Friday morning. Top five Aussies and top five Other Breed dogs for Friday & Saturday total scores in Sheep & Cattle will qualify for the Jackpot. Handlers can buy into the Jackpot for \$100.

DAILY WINNERS: Placement ribbons & qualifying ribbons.

DAILY CASH WINNERS: \$25 will be paid to each winner, with a Qualifying Score of Started, Open, Advanced & WTCH dogs on Ducks, Sheep & Cattle.

DAILY HIGH IN TRIAL WINNERS: Prizes for Started, Open, Advance, WTCH.

DAILY COMBINED HIGH IN TRIAL AUSSIE & HIGH COMBINED OTHER BREED: To be awarded a prize.

GILLESPIE TRAVELING TROPHY: To be awarded to the (3) day Combined High In Trial Aussie.

BELT BUCKLES: (3) Day Combined Score for Started, Open, Advanced & WTCH dogs. You must notify SWASA before the trial begins that you are competing for the buckles.

NOTE:

- 1) You must compete in only one division, the highest (started, open or advanced) that you trial in on Friday. You cannot have competed or earned titles or points in any other venue (AKC, AHBA etc...) to compete for the Started buckle.
- 2) The highest class that you enter the first day will determine the buckle you are competing for, ie: dog competing in Started sheep, ducks & cattle the first day & moves into the Open sheep class the second day will still compete for the Started buckle; dog in Open sheep & Started ducks & cattle the first day will compete for the Open buckle. A total of 9 scores will be combined & post Advanced may be run instead of Advanced if desired on Friday and Sunday.
- 3) As per the ASCA rules, you may continue to compete in a class if you qualify for the second leg, as long as 60 days has not expired since the second leg was earned.
- 4) If you are running one day in multiple classes (say Started duck & Open cattle & sheep) for COMBINED BELT BUCKLE CALCULATIONS ONLY, the Started score (awarded by the Judges) would be adjusted upwards by multiplying the Started score by 1.25. The Open or Advanced scores will not be adjusted. The score reported to ASCA will be the score awarded by the Judge, not the adjusted score.
