## DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE-ELBERT COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS, KIOWA, CO

**From the East,** take Highway 86 West (Kiowa) exit off I-70, go approximately 40 miles to Kiowa. Turn right onto the Kiowa-Bennett Road; the Elbert County Fairgrounds are ¼ mile on the left.

**From the West,** take Highway 86 East (in Castle Rock) exit off I-25 and go approximately 30 mile to Kiowa, turn left onto the Kiowa-Bennett Road; the Elbert County Fairgrounds are ¼ mile on the left.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

This is an ASCA sanctioned show and all ASCA rules apply ([www.asca.org](http://www.asca.org)). Dogs over 6 months of age must have proof of ASCA registration available. CASA, the Show Secretaries and club membership assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by any exhibitor, handler, dog, property, children or spectator. All dogs must be crated or leashed except while competing.

Entry fees will not be returned if the show cannot be opened or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies or other events beyond the control of CASA. Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the Show Committee, ASCA, show veterinarian or the judge.



**Pre-Entry Deadline:** Postmark for stock pre-entries no earlier than August 30th and close September 17th. Early postmarks will be returned. Postmark for conformation/obedience pre-entries by October 4<sup>th</sup>. Telephone, facsimile or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All entries must be on the official ASCA entry form with proper fees included. Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of the entry and the class entered. Withdrawals of entries will be accepted until the Pre-entry closing. Thereafter, no refunds will be made. Make checks payable to: CASA



**Stock Trial:** Substitutions are allowed providing the dog is owned by same owner. Draw for run order will be the day of trial by the Course Director. Bitches in heat will run in order of draw, but **must be crated and exercised away from the competition**. All breeds recognized by ASCA as herding breeds are eligible to enter the trial. Stock to be used: 5 head per run of Khaki Campbell ducks, 3-5 head per run of wool and/or hair sheep and 3-5 head per run of 400 to 700# red angus or mixed beef-type calves. Owners of dogs will be responsible for all injuries to livestock; replacement cost per duck is \$25, per sheep is \$150, per calf is \$600 unless posted otherwise at time of trial.

Obedience Trophies: High in Trial Overall and either High In Trial Aussie or Other Breed (whichever is not High in Trial Overall).

Conformation Trophies: Altered and Regular: Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex, Winners Dog, and Winners Bitch. Best Junior Handler and Reserve Junior Handler. Best of Breed Puppy and Best Opposite Sex Puppy.

Stock Trophies: High in Trial Ducks, Sheep, Cattle, Open, Started and Junior **combined total for each day**. Scores posted throughout the day and ribbons and awards given out at the end of each day. HIT Started, Open and Junior score ties will be broken by class of stock (cattle>sheep>ducks).

- SILVER BELT BUCKLES will be awarded to the High Combined WTCH, High Combined Non-WTCH, High Combined Started Aussie and High Combined Started Other Breed dogs for the weekend. High Combined Started awards based on started scores only.
- MOST PROMISING STARTED AUSSIE ( Judges' choice over the weekend)
- MOST PROMISING STARTED OTHER BREED (Judges' choice over the weekend)
- MOST VERSATILE AUSSIE (Nationals Rules).

Conformation and Obedience Ribbons: Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in the classes. Deluxe rosettes for Obedience-HIT, HIT Aussie and HIT Other Breed. Conformation-BOB, BOW, BOS, WD, WB, RWD, RWB, Best Junior, Reserve Junior, BOB Puppy and BOS Puppy.

Stock Ribbons: Ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place in each regular stock class. Deluxe rosettes will be awarded for: High in Trial Ducks, Sheep, Cattle, Junior, Open, Started, Aussie, Other Breed and High Combined WTCH, Non-WTCH, Started Aussie and Started Other Breed (combined scores for both days) and Most Promising Started Aussie.
