Bitches in season run last out of courtesy to other competitors, – please notify trial secretary.

Stock dog Trial

Trial limit: Limited by number of runs judge is permitted to judge in a day and stock limits.

A waiting list will be made in order of receipt if trial fills. Gate entries will be accepted at

1/2 hour prior to the trials. Order of run will be determined day of trial. Bitches in season will run last. Substitutions allowed. No refunds unless slot is filled by another dog.

Awards for Stock: High in Trial Aussie, High in Trial Other Breed, High Score Sheep, High Score Ducks, High Score Cattle, High Combined (highest combined qualifying scores from all 3, or 2 different classes of stock) High Combined non WTCH, Most Promising Started Aussie in Trial, Most Promising Started Other Breed, High Open Working Junior, High Working Junior Handler.

MASC is the Manitoba Australian Shepherd Club of Manitoba, an affiliate club of ASCA (Australian Shepherd Club of America). MASC is an ALL-BREED/MIXEDBREED club, with groups planning events in Herding, Tracking, Agility, and Obedience. New members welcome.
