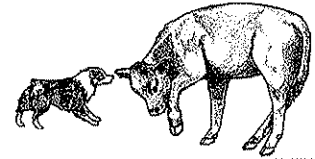

Take I-44 to NW side of Oklahoma City or the Kilpatrick Turnpike from I-35 to Hwy 74N (I-44 will turn into Hwy 74). Follow Hwy 74 North (Portland) to Waterloo. Turn left (west) on Waterloo and go to Rockwell. Turn right (north) on Rockwell and go to Simmons Road (First Road). Turn right (east) on Simmons Road. Trio Farms is the second drive on the left.

NOTE: To ensure hotels continue to allow our dogs, please be considerate & do not leave your dogs in the room unattended. It is also recommended your dogs be kenneled when in the room.

FOOD & BEVERAGES: Lunch fixins' & drinks will be available for purchase at the trial for \$5 per person.

NOTE: There are no restaurants near the trial site. If you don't wish to purchase food/beverages at the trial site, be sure & bring your own.

WEATHER: Be prepared for any type of weather & bring your own shade.

RIBBONS: Rosettes will be awarded for 1st place dog in each class.
Placement ribbons for 2nd through 4th place, and qualifying ribbons will be awarded.

AWARDS: Belt buckles to be awarded to High Combined Aussie each day and High Scoring Aussie in the Farm Trial.

Working Australian Shepherd Club of Oklahoma reserves the right to substitute a judge, if necessary.

Run order will be determined by random drawing and posted before the trial begins.

Bitches in season will run last.

Ties are broken by time.

Questions or conflicts should immediately be brought to the attention of the Course Director.

Owners of dogs will be responsible for all injuries to livestock. At stock owners option, dogs' owner will pay for veterinary services or, if necessary, replacement cost. Replacement costs are: Ducks—\$25.00, Sheep—\$125.00, Cattle—\$550.00; unless entrants are notified otherwise at trial time.

Owners/handlers are responsible for their dog(s). Dogs must be crated or on lead at all times, except when competing.

Owners/handlers are responsible for any damage done to or by themselves, their family, their visitors and/or their dogs. Children must be under direct adult supervision at all times. WASCO and/or Trio Farms are not responsible for any loss or accident.

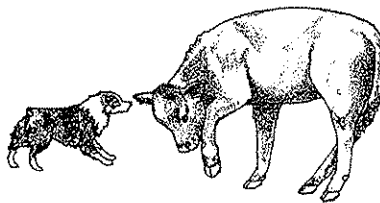
Time Limit: 25 minutes (a 10 minute & a 3 minute warning will be given to each handler)

- Handler Note:** Emphasis will be placed on calm, efficient, gentle stock handling as would be expected in a normal farm situation.
- Open Class:** Handler may assist the dog with any tasks as needed.
- Advanced Class:** The majority of each task should be completed with minimal handler assistance.

FARM TRIAL
September 11, 2010

1. From PEN 1 - sort off 5 head, 2 marked, 3 unmarked into PEN 2. Will be between 15-30 head in this pen.
2. In PEN 2, sort off 3 unmarked sheep into PEN 3.
3. In PEN 2 -Take the 2 marked sheep into chute, check feet on the one the judge chooses.
4. Load 2 sheep into the trailer.
5. Remove sheep from trailer and put back with 3 sheep in PEN 3.
6. Take all 5, drive or fetch to feed pan / leave dog to hold stock on feed pan.
7. Walk to open or advanced cone - Call dog to you.
8. When dog is at your side - send dog to gather stock to you. ADVANCED handlers do not leave cone. For open - dogs must be sent from cone, but handler can move.
9. Drive or fetch stock to the repen.
10. At repen, leave gate open... dog must not go down alley but hold / keep the stock from returning to the larger repen as the sheep are put in the smaller pen at the end by handler.

Course time is 25 minutes - with a 10 minute warning.



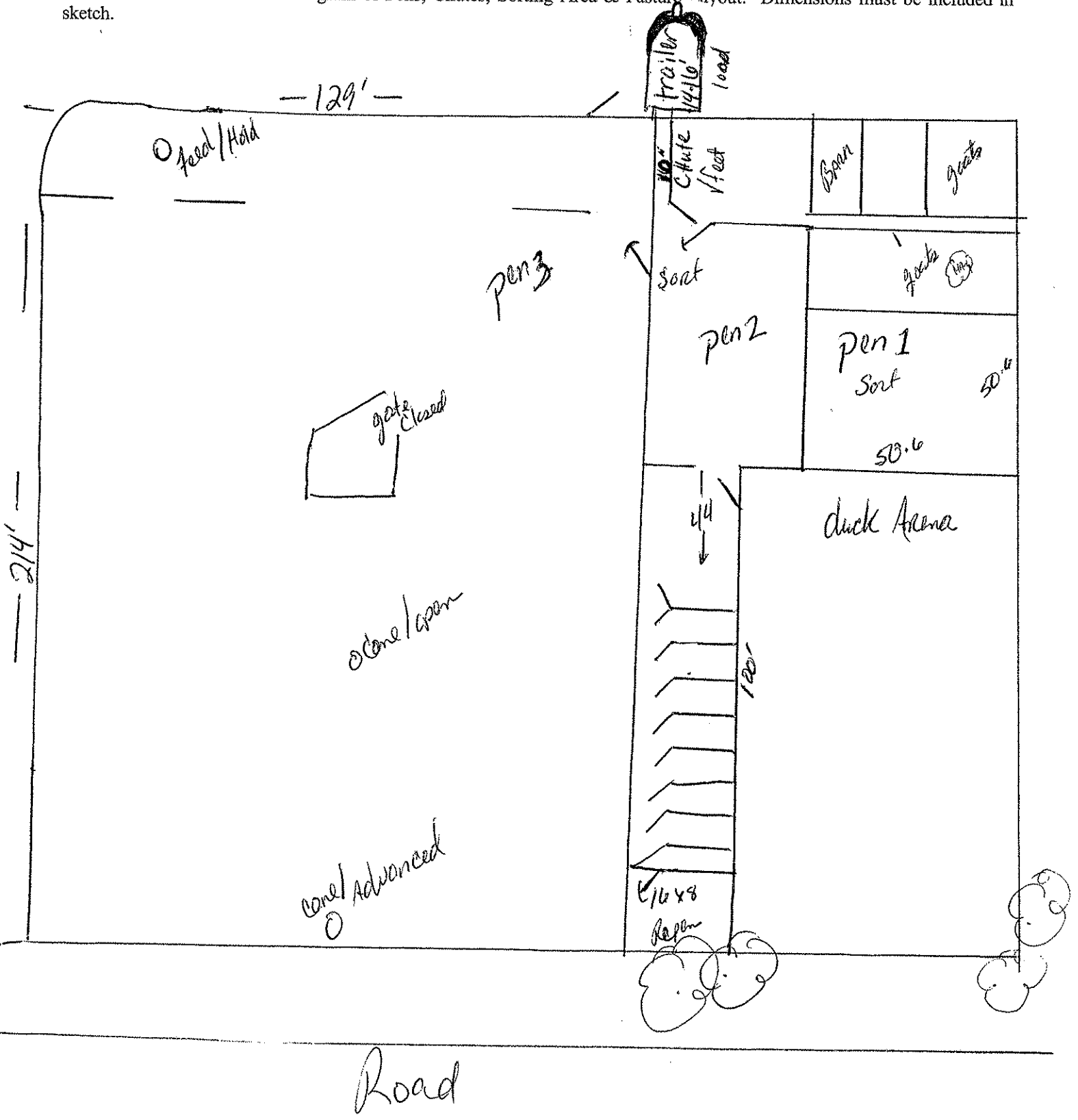
