**STOCK INFO:**

- Ducks: 5 head of mixed breed ducks**
- Goats: 3-5 head of Boer goat nannies**
- Cattle: 3-5 head of beef cattle**

**Directions to Beret Farms: 28222 Margerstadt Rd., Waller 77484**

From southbound I45 – Exit FM 1488 and turn right, heading west. You will pass through the town of Magnolia which is about one-half of the way to your next turn. After you go through Magnolia, you will also pass the Oak Hollow subdivision on the left. (You will also pass Joseph Rd. and Rice Rd.) Continue down 1488 and watch for San Bernard Electric Company, a small building on the right. Immediately after passing San Bernard, turn LEFT on Hegar Road. Turn LEFT on Joseph Rd. and then turn RIGHT on Kickapoo (church on the right corner and Kickapoo Retreat on the left). Continue several miles south on Kickapoo and then turn LEFT on Margerstadt. We are on Margerstadt about 8/10 of a mile down on the left. You will see a gray barn at the road with a sign, “NEAL’S SERVICE COMPANY” and “BERET KENNELS”, a tan office building and a green double-wide mobile home. Do NOT cross the bridge over the Spring Creek.

From Hwy 6 – Exit Houston/290 going east (Hempstead). See below.

From Houston, take Hwy 290 West and exit Kickapoo (turn right/north on Kickapoo) see below.

From Northwest Texas area - Take Hwy 290 East towards Houston. Exit Kickapoo and head NORTH. Cross FM 2920 and continue north on Kickapoo for about 2 miles. (At Imhoff, you will jog to the left then to right.) Turn right on Margerstadt. We are 8/10 of a mile down on the left. You will see a gray barn at the road with a sign, “NDSC, LLC” and “BERET KENNELS”, a green office building and a green double-wide mobile home. Do NOT cross the bridge over Spring Creek.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:**

**Trial rules of the Australian Shepherd Club of America will apply to this trial. Dogs should be leashed except when trialing and must be brought into the arena on leash. This is an ASCA sanctioned event and will be judged and run by the Stockdog be accepted on a first-come basis and must be on an ASCA entry form. Drawing for run order will be done on the day of the trial and posted. In ASCA all dogs must start trialing in the Started Class. No electrical and/or mechanical training devices are allowed on the trial grounds. Bitches in heat run last. Any questions, problems, or conflicts should be brought to the Course Director immediately. The Stockdog Trial Committee is authorized to request that any dog which, in the committee's opinion, represents a hazard to persons, dogs, or property by removed from the premises. All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times and clean up after your dogs as needed. Children must be kept under direct supervision of an adult at all times.**

**Please sign below release and mail back with your entry form.**

**I, \_\_\_\_\_, in consideration that I will be working stock at Beret Farms, home of Neal and Judy DeShazo, I do hereby agree that in the event of injury to myself, member of my family or one of my dogs or damage to my personal property, I will not hold Neal and/or Judy DeShazo liable. I further understand and agree that any livestock injured by my dog while working livestock will be paid for by me. Sheep/goats - \$200, Ducks \$25, Cattle - fair market value. I also agree to take full responsibility of my dog, keeping him chained or on lead while on the property of Beret Kennels. I will take full responsibility of my dog in the event of dog bites to other persons or dogs on the property and will cover the expense of doctor and/or veterinary expenses. I further agree to pay for any property damaged by myself or my dog, and any fences, gates, etc. damaged by stock as a result of my dog.**
