4 Stock Dog Trials - March 9th, 10th & 11th, 2012
Penn Y Caerau Farm Lady Lake, FL and BD Farm Bushnell, FL**

BD Farm

From Ocala - I-75 South to exit 314, Turn left (east on County Road 48) Continue to the 3rd traffic light, CVS on corner, Turn right on Main Street, travel to 2nd light, turn left on Seminole Ave., continue to flashing light and stop sign this is County Road 48 again, turn right continue 2.8 miles, there is guard railing on the left that ends where you will turn left onto County Road 561. This is a 1/2 mile-dead end, paved, tree lined road. The road ends at our gate. Gate has two statues.
From Tampa - I-75 North to exit 314, Turn right (east on County Road 48) Continue to the 3rd traffic light, CVS on corner, Turn right on Main Street, travel to 2nd light, turn left on Seminole Ave., continue to flashing light and stop sign this is County Road 48 again, turn right continue 2.8 miles, there is guard railing on the left that ends where you will turn left onto County Road 561. This is a 1/2 mile-dead end, paved, tree lined road. The road ends at our gate. Gate has two statues.

Penn Y Caerau Farm

From Ocala - Take 441/27 South, through Belleview, to Lady Lake. Go under "The Villages" bridge, at the second traffic light turn left onto Griffin Ave. (76 Gas Station on Left, CVS Drug Store on Right). After crossing over County Road 25 at traffic light, go straight about 1.3 mile to Penn Y Caerau Farm on the right, watch for signs
From Leesburg - Take 441/27 North to Lady Lake. At third traffic light, turn left onto County Road 25 North. At the first traffic light (about 1 mile), turn right onto Griffin Avenue, Penn Y Caerau is on the right about 1.3 miles, watch for signs.

Campers/RV's: Due to ground conditions there will be no RV daily or overnight parking at the trial sites.

Fri/Sun - Once cattle runs are completed sheep and ducks will begin 1.5 hours later at Penn Y Caerau Farm

Entries are on a first come basis. Sheep (5) and cattle (3) Course B, Ducks (5) will be course A.

Maximum of 50 runs each day. 12 Cattle, 10 Ducks & 28 Sheep

Each handler is responsible for his dog and must keep it under control at all times. Dogs will be brought to and from the arena on a leash. Handlers will be responsible for any damages to the livestock caused by their dogs, fair market value will apply.

Run order will be determined prior to trial. Females in heat run last.

Stock Dog Awards:

1st through 4th place, qualifying ribbons will be awarded for qualifying scores

Entries must be signed on the reverse side. Stock classes are open to dogs of any registry. Non-ASCA registered dogs must have an ASCA Tracking Number to compete. This form can be obtained from the ASCA web site www.asca.org

Attention Exhibitors: The shows will be judged and run under the show rules for the Australian Shepherd club of America. Dogs must be ready for judging. No refunds will be given for dogs absent, disqualified, excused or barred from exhibiting by the show committee. Rehinds will be given up to the close up the pre-entry deadline. Substitutions may be made with dogs owned by the exhibitor. No entry which specifies any condition as to its acceptance will be accepted. No electrical or mechanical training devices are allowed on the show grounds. Entries must be made on official ASCA entry forms. Copies of entry will be accepted only if they are completed with the agreement on the reverse side. The show giving club, show chairman, their agents, officers, and committee assume no responsibility for loss, damages, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or personal property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. FASA reserves the right to ban anyone not in good standing with ASCA from the show site.
