Setup/ Building Hours: Saturday and Sunday morning at 7:00am; (indoor facility with A/C, dirt surface). Building will close 30 minutes following last event each day.

Saturday Schedule:

- Rally: Judging begins at 9:00am - Check in for trial, and DOS entries from 8:00am-8:30am if available. Classes will run from Masters C through Novice A.
- Obedience: Judging begins at 12:30pm - Check in for trial, and DOS entries from 7:30am-10:00am if available. Classes will run in the following order Utility B,A, CDX B/A, ODX B/A, Novice B/A, Beginner Novice B/A, Non-Regular classes.

Sunday Schedule:

- Rally: Judging begins at 8:00am - Check in for trial, and DOS entries from 7:00am-7:30am if available. Classes will run from Masters C through Novice A.
- Obedience: Judging begins at 11:00am - Check in for trial, and DOS entries from 7:30am-10:00am if available. Classes will run in the following order Utility B,A, CDX B/A, ODX B/A, Novice B/A, Beginner Novice B/A, Non-Regular classes.

Fees:

Entry fees: First entry each trial \$20.00, second entry SAME dog, same trial \$15.00. Junior entry any trial: \$10.00.

Day of show entries if available: \$25.00 per entry. Juniors (same)

Awards:

Qualifying scores will receive a green ribbon; strip ribbons will be awarded for placements in each class. Rosettes will be awarded for High in Trial, High in Trial Australian Shepherd, and High in Trial Other Breed. Qualifying scores of 195 and higher will receive dark green strip ribbons indicating an "X" qualifying score.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Rally program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA. Bitches in season are not allowed to compete. All entries must be accompanied by a check or money order for the appropriate amount or will not be considered a valid entry and not be accepted for entry. No entry fees will be refunded. Make checks payable to NHASC. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and will be subject to a \$35 charge, and also reported to ASCA if restitution is not made in a very timely manner. No food, crates or dog treats will be allowed within 10 feet of the ring.

Directions:

From Austin-- Hwy 21 to Bryan. As you're coming into Bryan, turn RIGHT onto FM 2818 (Harvey Mitchell Parkway). Stay on 2818 all the way to College Station, and turn LEFT onto George Bush Dr. The pavilion will be on the RIGHT about 1/3 mile.

From Houston-- Hwy 290 west to Hempstead. Turn RIGHT onto Hwy 6 North. Take the "Business 6" exit (Business 6 becomes Texas Ave.) in College Station. Turn LEFT onto FM 2818 (Harvey Mitchell Parkway-- Walmart will be on the left). Go a couple miles on 2818, and turn RIGHT onto George Bush Dr. The pavilion will be on the RIGHT about 1/3 mile.

From Dallas/Ft. Worth-- I-35 South to Waco. From Waco, take Hwy 6 south all the way to Bryan. Take the "FM 2818—Bryan Business Park--George Bush Library" exit, and turn RIGHT onto FM 2818 (Harvey Mitchell Parkway). Stay on 2818 all the way to College Station, and turn LEFT onto George Bush Dr. The pavilion will be on the RIGHT about 1/3 mile.
