## Entry Fees and Information

Each trial is considered separately for entry fees. Single entry, single dog: \$20.00 (\$22.00 day of, if available) Double entry (Rally Excellent Masters) any single dog in each trial: \$35.00 (\$40.00). Junior entry any trial: \$10.00.

### *EXAMPLE ENTRY FEES:*

*One dog entered in one class for four trials  $\$20 \times 4 = 80$  (with pre-entry)*

*One dog entered in Excellent and Masters for four trials  $\$35 \times 4 = \$140$  (with pre-entry)*

Entry limited to number of runs that can be held in eight hours of judging spread over the two rally trials per day. Day of trial entries may be allowed at the discretion of the Rally Committee based on pre-entry numbers. Feel free to contact the trial chair or secretary with questions on entry limits before the day of the trial.

All breeds, including mixed breeds, may compete; however, they are required to have an ASCA Tracking number. This number may be applied for at the show. The tracking form application is available at

Owners/Handlers entering Novice Rally who have titled a dog in any registry in Novice must enter Novice B. Any dog entering Advanced or Excellent Rally who has earned a RA or RE or an equivalent title in any other registry, must enter Novice B, Advanced B or Excellent B, as appropriate.

## Trial Logistics

Class Order all trials: Masters C, B, A; Excellent C, B, A; Advanced C, B, A; Novice C, B, A  
Lunch to be at the discretion of the judge each day.

Building will open at 8:00 am each day and close one hour after the end of judging. No early set up on Friday, Sorry!

Light snacks will be available on site.

## **Awards**

Green Strip ribbons offered for every qualifying score, any class. Dark green ribbon for X scores (scores 195 and higher). Strip ribbons will be offered for placements. Rosettes offered for High In Trial, High in Trial Australian Shepherd, High in Trial Other Breed, and High Combined.

## **Policies**

Trials will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA. The rulebook is available at <http://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/sites/35/2016/04/newrallyrules.pdf>. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Rally program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA. Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete. Upon verification of being in heat by a veterinarian or the Rally Committee, the entry fee will be refunded if wished. Request for entry refunds will be honored if requested prior to close of pre-entries.
