ASCA agility trial in Sipoo, Finland, 19th–21st of May, 2017

Judge: Lora M Del Page

Trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA.

Classes offered:

Friday 19th May 2 Jumpers, 2 Gamblers, 2 Regular

Saturday 20th May 2 Regular, 2 Gamblers, 2 Jumpers

Sunday 21st May 2 Jumpers, 2 Gamblers, 2 Regular

Location: Rajakulmantie 220, 04430 Sipoo, Finland

The trial will take place indoors, on an artificial turf field,
30 x 30 metres in size.

Entries close on April 28th, 2017

Entry fees: run 10 €. FEO (For Exhibition Only) 10 €, 2-day package: all runs

for one dog 108 €, 3-day package: all runs for one dog 153 €

Day-of-trial entries not accepted, 350 runs max.

Note: In accordance with the Finnish law, docked or cropped dogs are not allowed to enter. If your dog has a natural bobtail, be prepared to prove it.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for the first four places in each event for each height division. Green ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying scores. Ribbons will also be awarded for titles completed at this trial.

High In Trial Awards will be awarded according to the calculation formulas used by Agility Unscrambled software: HIT points are calculated as SCT - dog's time + faults for Qualifying runs only. On each trial date, HIT Novice, Open, and Advanced are awarded.

Agility obstacles will include: Dog Walk (rubber chip contacts), A-Frame (rubber chip contacts), Teeter-Totter (rubber chip contacts), Winged Jumps, Double Bar Jump, Tire Jump, Open Tunnels, and Weave Poles (60 spacing)

This trial is open to all breeds and mixes. If your dog is an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd, fill in your dog's registration number where designated on the entry form. If your dog is not an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd and you would like to earn ASCA titles, you will need to obtain an ASCA QT number for your dog. The ASCA business office will track qualifying scores earned only by ASCA registered dogs. Once you have an ASCA QT number, use it as your dog's "ASCA Registration Number" on all entry forms.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA agility program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

1.1 As used here "ASCA" means the Australian Shepherd Club of America, its affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner release ASCA, the ASCA® affiliate/licensee club FINASC (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), and site owner(s) Järvenpään Agilityurheilijat ry (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor /owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

ASCA Service Membership and QT Number Application

In order to have ASCA trial points tracked and to receive titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA QT Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the QT number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type, Service, is required). ASCA membership does not have to be maintained in subsequent years.

It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify previous ASCA points earned when applying for a QT Number.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I have to have a QT number to compete?

- You do not need a QT number in order to compete in Agility or Stock, unless you want to earn ASCA titles.
- You will need a QT number to enter an Obedience Trial, Rally Trial, or Tracking Test.
- Your dog does not have to be a purebred to receive a QT number from ASCA.

Why would I need or want a QT number for my dog?

If you would like your dog's points recorded by ASCA, and receive title certificates in the mail for your accomplishments, you will need to obtain a QT number.

What is the total cost for a QT number?

In order to obtain a QT number for your dog, you must be a member. The cost for a basic Service Membership is **\$10 per owner** if not already a current member.

- Your membership is good for one year and does not need to be renewed unless you want to obtain another QT number for another dog after your membership has expired.

This membership fee is in addition to the QT number fee of **\$10** per dog.

A QT number is good for the lifetime of the dog. If you only have one dog, the total cost would be **\$20**. For two dogs, the cost would be **\$30**, etc.
