Trail will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA

Directions to trial site: From I-84 in Meridian, Idaho head South on S. Meridian Rd. towards Kuna.

Left on Hubbard Rd. Right on Locust Grove Rd. Temptation Arena is on your Right.

- The postmark (not the delivery date) will determine the entry order. Any Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without recipient signature.
- There will be a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee.

- Confirmations and other recommendations are sent primarily via e-mail. It is your responsibility to make sure that the secretary's email address of is allowed by your spam blocker, and to change options that strip attachments from emails.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial is sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of America with affiliate club ASC of Idaho

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at time of this trial including the following:

- All healthy, trained dogs are eligible to compete in ASCA Rally trials.
- Exhibitors should always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion.
- Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.
- Any dogs which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside or outside the ring, must be excused from the Rally trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in sufficient control to perform all the obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the Rally trial.
- Exhibitors agree that if their dog(s) is (are) left unattended, they will be secured in a crate or x-pen. Owner/handlers whose dogs are tethered or improperly secured will not be allowed on the show grounds.
- No food, toys tents, crates or other aids or devise shall be permitted within 10' of the ring.
- All dogs shall be on leash when not competing.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- The sponsoring club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result is accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.
- The organizing committee may not refuse any entry other than on the basis expressly provided through rules and regulations of the sanctioning organization. Anyone not currently in good standing with ASCA will not be allowed to enter the trial.
- Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption list. Description of classes, levels and division are included in the current ASCA Rally Rules and regulations Handbook. A copy of the handbook may be downloaded free from the ASCA website: www.asca.org
