

Classes offered and sequence of judging:

Jr. Handling: Pee-Wee 3-5, Sub Jr 6-7, 8-12 Novice, 8-12 Open, 13-17 Novice, 13-17 Open, BJH

Non-Regular Classes (Divided by Sex): 2-4 Month Puppy, 4-6 Puppy, BOB Puppy

Regular Altered & Intact (Divided by Sex): 6-9, 9-12, 12-15, 15-18, Novice, Am. Bred, Bred-By, Open (Divided by Color), Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best of Breed

Awards: Ribbons 1st – 4th Place, Rosettes, awards all shows, all days. Great junior prizes!

Driving Directions from the North: take I-15 exit 325. Turn right onto Park Lane. Go to the roundabout and take the 3rd exit (Eastbound Clark Lane). Turn right (South) on to the road between the DMV and Correctional Center. Follow the road past the horse barns and blue buildings. We are in building #3 (South building).

Driving Directions from the South: take I-15 exit 322. Continue to the stop light and make a left. Follow road over freeway and continue straight through the next light. Turn left (South) on to the road between the DMV and Correctional Center. Follow the road past the horse barns and blue buildings. We are in building #3 (South building).

Facility Accommodations: The show will be held indoors on a high quality matted floor. The ring is 100% matted. Electricity is available. Grooming will be in the same building, but all hair must be picked up and noise kept to a minimum. The show grounds are available at 7:00 AM.
