Awards: Flat ribbons will be awarded to 1st thru 4th places. Green Qualifying ribbons for scores of 170-194, X Qualifying ribbon for scores of 195 and higher. Rosettes for High in Trial, High Combined, High in Trial Australian Shepherd if High in Trial is not an Australian Shepherd, and High in Trial Junior at the end of each trial. All trials limited to 40 runs each

Entry fees: \$20 each class pre-entered, \$24 day of trial, entries taken ½ hour before trial. Rally entry forms can be found at www.asca.org Please make checks payable to NYASA. Entries open Feb. 1, and close March 5, 2018. Enter all 4 trials for \$75.00. Trial secretary is Mary-Lou Trone. Building will open at 8am. Bring water for your dog. Lunch will be available.

ASCA RULES: This event will be held under the current rules and regulations of the Australian Shepherd Club of America (ASCA). No entry will be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA. All ASCA venue rulebooks can be found at www.asca.org. All Rally dogs must have an ASCA Novice title before entering Advanced, an ASCA Advanced title before entering Excellent, and an ASCA Excellent title before entering Masters. No bitches in season allowed to participate.
