Day of Show/Trial Entries:

Entries taken each day from 8:00 am to 9:00 am, and between trials/shows.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. All entries must be submitted on the latest approved ASCA entry form, for the event in which your dog is entered. Entry forms are available on the ASCA website, at www.asca.org/home/business-office/rules-forms. All non-ASCA dogs must have a QT Number in order to compete in obedience or rally trials. QT Number applications are available on the ASCA website, or are available at the trial site.
2. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
3. No bitches in season will be allowed to participate in any rally or obedience trial.
4. Refunds of pre-show entries will be refunded only upon written request prior to close of pre-entries. No other refunds will be granted. No class changes will be allowed once entries have closed on the day of the show or trial.
5. Any check returned to our bank will invalidate all entries associated with that check. In addition, the writer of said check will be reported to ASCA. Any person with a check returned for insufficient funds will be required to pay all future event fees in cash.
6. Dogs over 6 months of age must have proof of ASCA registration available.
7. SCASC, the show secretaries, and club membership assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by any exhibitor, handler, dog, property, children or spectator.
8. All dogs must be crated or leashed except while competing.
9. Show building will be open and available to exhibitors for setup at 7:30 am on both Saturday and Sunday. Building will be closed and locked each evening. No dogs may be left in show building overnight. Contact Show Coordinator for information regarding building access.
10. Trials and shows will be held indoors, on concrete floors covered with rubber matting. Crating space and grooming spaces are available in the building. Electricity is available; you may need an extension cord to reach an outlet near your setup.
11. Driving directions: Please use Google Maps or Mapquest for best directions to the site from your location.
12. No food concessions on premises, but lots of places to eat close by in Castle Rock.
