****Conformation Rule Book 9.9 Communicable Disease

No dog shall be eligible to compete at any show, no dog shall be brought into the grounds or premises of any dog show, and any dog which may have been brought into the grounds or premises of a dog show shall immediately be removed, if it;

a. shows clinical symptoms of distemper, infectious hepatitis, parvovirus, leptospirosis, kennel cough or other communicable disease, or

b. is known to have been in contact with distemper, infectious hepatitis, leptospirosis, kennel cough or other communicable disease within thirty days prior to the opening of the show, or

c. has been kenneled within thirty days prior to the opening of the show on premises on which there existed distemper, infectious hepatitis, leptospirosis, kennel cough or other communicable disease.****

Directions From I-95: I-95 to ID55; East (towards Marsing) ½ mile; left on Edison; 2 miles then right on Dunlap; ½ mile then at end of pavement turn right onto Gosling Lane and look for Boise ASC signs.

Directions From I-84: I-84 exit 33A (ID55) towards Marsing/Winnemucca; 14 miles, cross the Snake river & turn right on Bruneau Hwy; 2.5 miles to 'T' intersection and turn right on Edison; ½ mile then right on Dunlap; at end of pavement turn right onto Gosling Lane and look for Boise ASC signs.

Rules & Disclaimers

- All events will be governed by the rules and regulations of ASCA, which will be strictly enforced.
- All entries must be on current official ASCA forms with the agreement/disclaimer signed - Entry form may be found here: <http://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/conftxentry.pdf>
- All dogs 6 mos. and older must have individual registrations to compete in any ASCA event
- Juniors must enter all required information
- Incorrect or incomplete information will invalidate entry
- Entries will not be accepted for any dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program or all ASCA programs, or any person not in good standing with ASCA.
- Entry fees must accompany the entry, and must be paid prior to the show.
- Withdrawals of entries will be accepted until the pre-entry closing date. Thereafter no refunds will be made.
- Entry fees will not be returned if the show cannot be opened or completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies or other events beyond the control of Boise ASC, nor refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the show committee, ASCA, show veterinarian or the judge.
- Exhibitors and Owners assume all risk associated with participation in these events and hold all hosts harmless from same.
- There are no known local ordinances in conflict with showing dogs at this facility.
- Checks returned for NSF will be assessed a \$40 service fee.
- Please help keep our host facility clean by picking up after yourself and your dogs and disposing of waste in designated trash receptacles. Thank you!
