3-5 head hair sheep, 3 head beef cattle 5 head mixed breed ducks per run

Classes: Std.\* Open \*Adv.\* JR & Novice handler and FEO

No Entry fees refunded without veterinary Excuse. Substitutions are allowed only with a dog you own or co-own.

Rules for filling runs: You must notify the trial secretary of any changes to your entries. The changes will be recorded for each change.

If the trial does not fill & if you don't do your run, you forfeit your entry fee. No selling of your runs to another unless trial does not fill. We will keep the entries in the trial by date received. Those on the wait list have priority for runs offered that come available. If the trial fills and if there is a waiting list that fills your opening to replace your runs you will get your entry fee back.

Bitches in season will run in order and must be crated until runs

Run order drawn before trial date and will posted before each trial.

Cattle loss will be market value of animal. Sheep loss 200.00 per head.  
Ducks 20.00 per duck.

**Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> place – qualifying flat green ribbons**  
Rosettes only to High Cattle, Sheep and Ducks each day.

High Combined Post Advanced sheep and cattle(scores from Sat and Sun)

High Combined Adv Aussie and BC

High Combined Open Aussie and BC

Combined scores selected from Sat –Sun- Mon

All scores will be counted Must enter all 3 types of stock

High combined Adv will come from advanced scores

High combined open will come from open scores

High combined Started scores and Most Promising Started Aussie will come from started classes

**You can move up at any time but you must compete in all classes of stock for the buckle. Scores from only one division will count toward buckle. Only one buckle per division awarded. You must declare which division you want to compete in.**

**You may compete in different division with another dog**

**If there is only one dog in the division you must compete in all classes each day.**

**Remember: This is private property. We will ask you to leave if you abuse your dog or the livestock with no refund to you for runs not completed. Please do not leave your children or your dogs unattended. You will be liable for damages you, your children or dogs cause. Dogs must be on leash until they start their runs. Bitches in season crated until their run.**
