Intact and altered entrants will be shown together. Only the dog's movement will be judged. No hands-on examination completed by the judge.

On Sunday entries will be taken 8:30am – 9:00am and again on Sunday following the end of the AM show, closing 15 minutes prior to the start of the PM show. All entries must be complete and paid for at the time of entry or they cannot be accepted.*

**ENTRIES** - All ASCA registered dogs over 6 months old must show proof of registration. No entry shall be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or any person not in good standing with ASCA. All entries must be on a current ASCA entry form. Available online at <http://asca.org/Portals/0/showentrywtx.pdf>

**Any check returned to our bank will invalidate all entries associated with that check. In addition, all exhibitors and/or owners for which a check has been returned will be reported to ASCA - NO EXCEPTIONS.** NorCal will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Any exhibitor/owner with a check returned must pay all future NorCal event fees by cash, money order, and/or cashier's check.

**Refund of entries** - Pre-entries will be refunded only upon written request received prior to close of pre-entries. *No other entry refunds will be granted.*

## **SHOW / TRIAL RINGS, DAY SET UPS, & ELECTRICITY ACCESS**

The ring will be located on the north most grass lawn. We recommend that you bring sun and wind protection. ***No day of show set ups are allowed on the show lawn until 8:00 a.m. Saturday in order to allow for the show committee to set up for the show. Roping off or “pre-reserving” of day set up spots will not be allowed prior to 8:00am on Saturday.***

WASOC will be hosting Obedience & Rally Trials on the same lawn, so ***please do not potty dogs near their obedience/rally ring(s).***

**IMPORTANT NOTE REGARDING ELECTRICITY HOOK-UPS** – The fairgrounds will allow for day of show electricity hook ups, free of charge; however, all day of show hook ups must be unplugged at the end of the show or ***you will be charged \$30 for an overnight electrical hook up. Please remember if fairground personal finds that you are plugged when they inspect at the end of the show, you will be charged.***

**This is a fairground rule for which NorCal has no control and can provide no exceptions.**

## **OVERNIGHT RV & TENT CAMPERS**

**We cannot guarantee RV parking spots will be available if not reserved and paid for by May 19, 2018. Please read this entire section for important information.**

RV and/or paid camping sites (with electricity) will be located at the northern end of the “North Lawn” across from the NorCal & WASOC show/trial lawn. Please include your request for RV / camping with your pre-entries. The cost of RVs and/or camping are as follows and **all fees must be paid in full prior to release of your arm band numbers.**

- RV, Camper, Trailers (regardless of electrical hook up) - \$30 per night\*\*
- Tent or Van/Car Camping with electrical hook up – \$30 per night\*\*
- Tent or Van/Car Camping with NO electrical hook up – \$15 per night\*\*

**\*\*These are the rates mandated by the fairground rates.**

The school lawn area is limited to tent campers unless otherwise instructed by NorCal. There will be no RV set ups or camping allowed on the NorCal / WASOC show/trial lawn without prior consent of NorCal ASC.

RV sites for the ASCA show/trial will be available beginning Friday, May 27<sup>th</sup> at noon. Please drive slowly when entering the fairgrounds so as not to interfere with the agility trial. There will be a large number of RV and campers expected at the fairgrounds over the show weekend as there is an agility trail on the grounds as well.

We ask that everyone please be courteous to the agility club members and their exhibitors when coming in with RV's, etc. Thank you!!
