Entry Limits	<p>Entries are limited to 400 runs a day. Trial entries will close whenever the limit is reached. In the event entries fill, priority will be given to the first 25 volunteers working two classes per day.</p>		
Opening and Closing dates	<p>Opening: Entries will be accepted with postmarks dated <i>no earlier</i> than Friday, June 1, 2018.</p> <p>Closing: Entries that arrive by 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 25, 2018, or when entry limits are reached. CONFIRMATIONS, including information regarding classes you have entered, will be emailed to all entrants who have provided a valid email. **PLEASE READ YOUR CONFIRMATIONS!** General information will be mailed to all entered about a week before the trial and will include site information, check-in time, walk-through/start times and tentative class running orders.

CLASS CHANGES: Moveups must be submitted in writing (email ok) and must be received by the Trial Secretary before **5:00 PM Tuesday, July 31, 2018.**

Moveups will be allowed at the trial from Saturday to Sunday – all moveup requests must be on received within 30 minutes after the last class has finished on Saturday. **NO Exceptions!**

AWARDS: PASA offers ribbons for First through Fourth place in each class for each jump height division. 20+” and 24” dogs will be scored together. Ribbons in the ASCA color of green will be offered to every dog obtaining a qualifying score. Dogs that complete an ATCH receive a large rosette and a decorated pole for signing.

HIGH IN TRIAL AWARDS will be awarded to the highest scoring dog(s) in the following categories (6 awards in all): Rosettes to HIT in the Novice, Open and Elite levels (Standard division), Junior and Veteran Divisions and the highest overall ACE dog. A dog's category will be based upon the level/division in which the dog competes in its last Regular class. All Qs are counted. Qs receive 5 points for Novice, 6 points for Open and 7 points for Elite. Faulted Qs receive ½ the value. High point dog in each category is the winner. Ties will be broken using first the YPS in qualifying Regular classes, then average gamble points.

Silver Buckle Series: All dogs with a qualifying run, which have a chance to win their category; will be entered in the 2018 Silver Buckle Series. Awards will be presented at the November Trial to the top Elite, Open, Novice, Veteran, ACE & Jr. Handler dog. For details, see the events page at www.pasadogs.com.

Special Equipment Notes: We have 24” weaves, separating tire and all contacts are rubberized.

However, please note: **PASA is going GREEN!** PASA will keep competitors supplied all day with hot and cold water, coffee, etc. **HOWEVER**, in an effort to reduce the impact of our trials on our natural resources, we will no longer provide disposable cups or bottled beverages. You must bring your own travel mug or drinking bottle from home to fill up as needed. We are also encouraging all competitors to cart home their recyclables, which otherwise club members have to personally sort and dispose of. If you cannot take recyclables home, please empty, crush and place them in any of the clear plastic garbage bags you will see near the regular trash bins.

POTLUCK Saturday night – Bring something to share and your own non-alcoholic drink.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. A copy of ASCA's Agility Rulebook may be downloaded free from the ASCA web site: www.asca.org.

All dogs must be on a leash when not competing in the ring. No set ups within 15 feet of any ring.

Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. In all cases, regardless of the situation, the judge's decisions are final.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from ASCA agility or all ASCA programs; or a member/person not in good standing with ASCA. The organizing committee may refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through ASCA rules and regulations or guidelines established by the ASCA Board of Directors.

Equipment list: Jumps, tunnels, 24" weave poles, separating tire, teeter, slatted dog walk and A-frame. All contacts are rubberized. Electronic timing will be used.

Note: Junior Handlers are under 18 years. Novice A is for dogs, owners and handlers who have never earned an agility title in any venue.

Refunds: No refunds are given for entries withdrawn after the closing date. No refund is given if a dog or handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason. No refund is given if the trial cannot open or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of god, public emergency, acts of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the Show Committee's control. The show will not be cancelled in the event of rain. Refunds of the entry fees paid will be issued for injured dogs or bitches in season if submitted to the trial secretary in writing by 8 a.m. on Saturday before the trial. A letter from your vet indicating the dog's condition may be requested in order to process the refund.

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check. ASCA will be notified if any fees are not received within 30 days of notice. All awards must be returned within 10 days of notification. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is cancelled without recourse by owner/handler.

Please clean up after yourself and your dog. Please also keep hotel rooms and grounds clean so that hotels will continue to allow dogs to stay.

The Show Committee will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result was by accident or any other cause.

It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Please take responsibility for your dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. There will be no refunds for entries if a dog or handler is dismissed from competition for any reason.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – CONTINUED

PERMANENT MEASUREMENT CARDS – Dogs with a standard jump height of 20+" or greater do not need to be measured. All other heights must be measured or present an ASCA, NADAC or AKC permanent height card.

Beginning 1/1/2003 for non-ASCA registered dogs – In order to have ASCA qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Qtracking Number. **This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog.**

At the time of applying for the Qtracking number, **the individual owner must also be an ASCA member** (minimum membership type of 'Service' is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA the shows and legs earned when applying for a QTracking Number for those ASCA qualifying legs earned from 1/1/2003 until submitting the application.
