SEE NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS UNDER WITHDRAWALS

This tracking trail will be held under ASCA Tracking Rules and Regulations.

The drawings for entries and alternates for slots in the test will be conducted in accordance with The drawings for entries and alternates for slots in the test will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 20 of the ASCA Tracking Rules and Regulations.

The Draw for test entry: A random draw for entries and alternate list for each day will be held on Friday June 8 2018 at 4 PM at DCS, Romerweg 20, 5975 PL Sevenum, The Netherlands.

The Draw priority in the "Draw for Test Entries" shall be given in the following order:

1. To all ASCA registered Australian Shepherds, including those previously titled through ASCA TD2 or ASCA TDU2, or TD and TDU, or untitled but with certifications or equivalent titles.
2. To all dogs with ASCA Office QT Numbers, including those previously titled through ASCA TD2 or ASCA TDU2, or TD and TDU, or untitled but with certification or equivalent titles.
3. To ASCA registered Australian Shepherds with three or more TD/TDU titles,
4. To dogs with ASCA office QT Numbers with three or more TD/TDU titles,
5. To a non-titled ASCA registered Australian Shepherd without a certification or equivalent title,
6. To a non-titled dog with and ASCA office QT numbers without a certification or equivalent title.

When the advertised limit of entries has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth in the preceding paragraph, shall be drawn for a position on the Alternate List.

Alternate List: An alternate list shall be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date, but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for the limited entries.

Notification: results of the draw will be sent ASAP following the draw.

Draw June 19 & 20 2018 test running order:

TD Tracking Dog tracks will be drawn at **June 19 2018 at 8:30 am** at the test site. **TDU** Tracking Dog tracks will be drawn at **June 19 2018 at 1 pm** at the test site.

TD tracking Dog tracks will be drawn at **June 20 2018 at 8:30 PM** at the TD test site. **TDU** Tracking Dog tracks will be drawn at **June 20 2018 at 1 pm** at the test site.

All dogs that entered (a particular day, June 20 or June 21) must be at the test site at the time of their draw for running order of the tracks. Entrants not present at their draw will be marked absent and alternate(s) will be allowed to run in their place(s).

Judging will begin when the tracks have sufficiently aged.

Withdrawals must be made in writing to the test secretary. Withdrawals cannot be accepted if the test does not fill. Notification of withdrawal must be made 48 hours prior to the test in order to secure an entrant to take your place. Alternates will take the place of withdrawals in the numerical order in which they were drawn. If the alternate can take your place, your entry fee will be refunded. If there are no alternates, your entry fee will not be refunded

ASCA QT NUMBER: For non-ASCA registered dogs – in order to have ASCA qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA QT Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the QT number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type of "Service" is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. Go to the following web site for QT number and membership application: <http://asca.org/Portals/0/trackapp.pdf>

Bitches in Season may participate. The Tracking Test Secretary and Judge will be notified that a bitch is in season prior to the drawing for tracks. The last track to be laid shall be reserved for the bitch in season. Bitches in season will be allowed to participate in a Tracking Test only after all the other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested.

Dogs not being tested must be leashed or in a crate. No loose dogs are allowed on site.

Awards: DWAS will offer a qualifying ribbon and a special gift to all passing Tracking Dog and Handler teams.
