About The Facility

Syracuse Obedience Training Club (SOTC) is a fully matted, air conditioned, indoor facility in one large room. Crating and grooming space is available near the conformation ring. NO CHALKING is permitted inside of the building. Crates must be able to be stacked if necessary, and no exercise pens will be permitted indoors. There is ample parking space provided, but limited grassy area. All exhibitors are required to clean up behind their dogs. Absolutely no dogs may be left in the building overnight, and dogs may only enter and exit the building through the SOTC entrance. There will be a food vendor on site. Located near Carrier Circle, there is easy access to Syracuse Hancock International Airport.

Conformation Information, Altered and Intact

Conformation will be held indoors on matting. There will be nearby set-up areas for grooming and crating (stackable crates, no ex-pens). Dog and Bitch schedules will be sent with confirmation of entry. Class schedule is subject to change. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for having their dog at the ring when their class is called to be judged. Neither the Host Club nor its Show Committee is responsible or obligated to furnish any service of notifying exhibitors of their class judging. Dogs will enter the ring in catalog order unless otherwise posted.

Awards include BOB, BOS, BOW, WD, WB, Reserve WD, Reserve WB, and Premier Dogs and Premier Bitches.

Junior Handling Information

Ownership rules must be followed to earn points. Please refer to the ASCA Rules and Regulations for Junior Handling and Junior Finals at www.asca.org. A change of dogs must be made at least one hour prior to the judging of the class and be approved by the Junior Chairperson.

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

HONYASC reserves the right to amend, correct and/or change any information contained herein due to any errors or unforeseen circumstances including but not limited to the amount of entries received necessitating judge and/or schedule changes.

Classes offered, in order:

PUPPY SWEEPS: 2-4 month, 4-6 month, 6-9 month, 9-12 month, 12-15 month, 15-18 month, divided by gender. Class winners to compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

JUNIORS: Pee Wee & Sub Juniors (no further competition); 8 - 12 & 13 - 17 (Divided into Novice & Open) Class winners to compete for Best Jr. Handler and Reserve Jr. Handler.

NON REGULAR: 2 - 4 & 4 - 6 months (divided by sex); class winners to compete for BOB & BOS puppy. Stud Dog; Brood Bitch; Veterans ages 7-10 years & 11+ years; Veteran class winners to compete for BOB & BOS;

ALTERED: 6 - 9, 9-12, 12-15, 15-18, Novice, Am. Bred, Bred by Exhibitor Open Blue Merle, Open Red Merle, Open Black & Open Red (divided by sex). Class winners compete for Winners Dog / Winners Bitch. Alt. Winners Dog & Bitch will compete with Alt. Specials for Alt. BOB, BOS & BOW.

The Dinosaur Bar-B-Que began life in 1983 as a mobile concession stand using a 55-gallon drum cut in half. Our cookbook, Dinosaur Bar-B-Que: An American Roadhouse, was voted as one of the best BBQ cookbooks in 2002 by the National Association of BBQ.
