No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA conformation program; a dog

Or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs: or a person not in good standing with ASCA. A dog that is using a chip or chemical implant to lower hormone levels is not eligible to be shown in either Regular Altered or Intact classes (Sections 4.15.1 and 9.6 Show Rules)

Jr. Handling: Pee Wee 3-5, Sub Jr 6-7, 8-12 Novice, 8-12 Open, 13-17 Novice, 13-17 Open

Non-regular Classes: (Divided by sex): 4-6 month puppy

**Regular Altered & Intact (Divided by sex): 6-9, 9-12, 12-15, 15-18, Novice, Am Bred, Bred-by
Open (Divided by color), Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best Of Breed**

COSTUME CLASS: Anyone can enter dogs and handlers must be dressed up in costume. All juniors will get a goody bag. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will win cash from the entries paid. Please have fun with this!!!

Driving directions from the north: 1-15 exit 325. Turn right onto Park Lane. Go to the roundabout and take the 3rd exit (Eastbound Clark Lane). Turn right (South) onto the road between the DMV and the Correctional Center. Follow the road past the horse barns and blue buildings. We are in building 2 (middle building).

Driving directions from the south: 1-15 exit 322. Continue to stop light and make a left. Follow road over freeway and continue straight through the next light. Turn left (South) onto the road between the DMV and the Correctional Center. Follow the road past the horse barns and blue buildings. We are in building 2 (middle building).

Facility Accommodations: The show will be held indoors on a high quality matted floor. The ring is 100% matted. Electricity is available. Grooming will be in the same building, but please pick up all hair. Once the show has started please do not turn on your dryers. The show grounds are available at 7:00 AM.

Overnight Camping: Overnight camping is available Friday and Saturday night for \$10.00 a night. Please include with entries. The price is \$15.00 for day of show per night if not pre-paid. No hookups available.
