No Entry fees refunded without vet excuse. Substitutions are allowed only with a dog you own or co-own. If the trial does not fill and after close of entries, if you don't run, you forfeit your entry fee. You can substitute a dog but you cannot sell your run. There may be dogs on the waiting list

Remember: This is private property so treat it as if it is your own. We will ask you to leave if you abuse your dog or the livestock with no refund to you for runs not completed. Please do not leave your children or your dogs unattended. You will be liable for damages you, your children or dogs cause. Dogs must be on leash until they start their runs.

Cattle loss will be market value of animal.

Sheep loss will be 250.00 per head.

Ducks will be 20.00 per duck

If livestock is injured and needs vet care you will be expected to pay for the vet. Also compensation to stock owner for time after trial for care of animal.

Directions: I-5 to exit 14. Turn east. Go 3 miles to Glenyan campground.

Turn right on Nell Creek and follow signs 2 miles to the Frey Ranch.
