**STOCK INFO:**

**Ducks: 5 head of Cayuga, Campbell or Runner ducks (limited to 10 runs per trial)**

**Sheep: 3 to 5 head of hair sheep**

**Cattle: 3 to 5 head of beef cattle (limited to 12 runs per trial)**

**Replacement value: Cattle – fair market value, ducks - \$40, sheep \$200**

**AWARDS: Placement ribbons 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup>. Rosettes for HIT Aussie and other breed. Special awards for HIGH COMBINED WTCH, Non-WTCH, open, started and other breed.**

**Awards will be given at the end of the day.**

**The High Combined awards will be the total of all QUALIFYING scores for the 3-day weekend.**

**Directions to Beret Farms: 28222 Margerstadt Rd., Waller 77484**

**From southbound I45 – Exit FM 1488 and turn right, heading west. You will pass through the town of Magnolia which is about one-half of the way to your next turn. After you go through Magnolia, you will also pass the Oak Hollow subdivision on the left. (You will also pass Joseph Rd. and Rice Rd.) Continue down 1488 and watch for San Bernard Electric Company, a small building on the right. Immediately after passing San Bernard, turn LEFT on Hegar Road. Turn LEFT on Joseph Rd. and then turn RIGHT on Kickapoo (church on the right corner and Kickapoo Retreat on the left). Continue several miles south on Kickapoo and then turn LEFT on Margerstadt. We are on Margerstadt about 8/10 of a mile down on the left. You will see a gray barn at the road with a sign, “NEAL’S SERVICE COMPANY” and “BERET KENNELS”, a tan office building and a green double-wide mobile home. Do NOT cross the bridge over Spring Creek.**

**From Northwest Texas area - Take Hwy 290 East towards Houston. Exit Kickapoo and head NORTH. Cross FM 2920 and continue north on Kickapoo for about 2 miles. (At Imhoff, you will jog to the left then to right.) Turn right on Margerstadt. We are 8/10 of a mile down on the left. You will see a gray barn at the road with a sign, “NDSC, LLC” and “BERET KENNELS”, a tan office building and a green double-wide mobile home. Do NOT cross the bridge over Spring Creek.**

## GENERAL

**This trial will be run under ASCA rules and regulations:**

**Central Texas Working ASA reserve the right to substitute a judge, if necessary.**

**Run order will be determined by random drawing and posted before the trial begins.**

**Bitches in season will run in draw order and must remain crated when not competing.**

**Ties are broken by time.**

**Questions or conflicts should immediately be brought to the attention of the Course Director.**

## RESPONSIBILITIES

**Owners of dogs will be responsible for all injuries to livestock. At stock owners option, dogs' owner will pay for veterinary services or, if necessary, replacement cost. Cattle= \$Fair market value, Sheep = \$250/head, Ducks = \$40/head.**

**Owners/handlers are responsible for their dog(s). Dogs must be crated or on lead at all times, except when competing.**

**Children must be under direct adult supervision at all times.**

**Central Texas Working ASA, its' officers and members assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor, handler, dog, property, child or spectator. Trialing is inherently dangerous. Ground/footing is uneven. Knowing this, you assume full liability for yourself, dog and stock if any damage is caused by you or your dog to stock or others. We thank you for cleaning up after your dogs.**

## ENTRIES & FEES

No telephone, facsimile, email or incomplete entries will be accepted. All entries must be on ASCA entry forms with proper fees included (<http://www.asca.org/portals/O/stockentry.pdf>)

The entry limit per Judge will be accepted in postmark order. If a class of stock is full the dog will be put on a waiting list in order of receipt.

Any entries received postmarked after pre-entry closing date will be placed on the waiting list, in postmarked order. Additions will be made prior to the start of the trial from the waiting list and are at the discretion of CTWASA.

In the event that any dog is deemed absent prior to April 18, 2019, its' trial slot(s) will be filled from the waiting list and any entry fee(s) will be refunded to the original entrant only, unless the original entrant provides a substitute dog. *Substitutions will be allowed with the following restriction: the substitute dog must be owned by the original entrant.*

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified by a judge, or barred from competition by the trial committee. Entry fees will be refunded if excused in writing by a veterinarian.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire and/or dangerous weather conditions, acts of God, public emergencies, acts of public enemy, strikes or other causes beyond the control of CTWASA.

Selling runs is not permitted unless the trial is full. If the trial is full and you wish to sell a run, the transaction must be handled by the trial secretary. All offers to buy or sell runs must be submitted to the trial secretary at least one hour before the trial starts.

Any checks returned for insufficient funds will be considered a void entry. There is a \$25 service charge for returned checks. If entries are resubmitted, payment must be in the form of cash, Money Order or Cashiers' Check.

This trial is open to all ASCA approved herding breeds. Non-ASCA dogs may enter the stock trial without a tracking number; however, only those with a tracking number will be awarded ASCA titles upon completing title requirements.
