Day of show entries will be taken for 10 minutes after AM Best of Breed.

Directions:

I-405 N or S Exit on Hawthorne Blvd. Go South approximately 5 miles. Go 2 signals past Pacific Coast Highway and up the hill about 1/8 mile to Ernie Howlett Park entrance on the right.

I-91 W to Harbor Fwy 110 S. and exit on Pacific Coast Highway. Turn right on PCH. Turn left on Hawthorne Blvd. Go 2 signals and uphill about 1/8 mile to Ernie Howlett Park.

Please Google or Mapquest your individual directions for your best route.

6. Vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas only. Vehicles parked in bike path or fire lane adjacent entry road are subject to towing at vehicle owner's expense.
7. Electrical outlets are not available.

All entries must be on a current ASCA entry form. Juniors must use a separate entry.

All entries must be completed (with agreement signed on back) or they will be refused.

Dogs 6 months & over must have ASCA Registration number on entry form.

No entry shall be accepted or refunded from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

Events will be held under current rules and regulations of ASCA

Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the show committee, ASCA, the show veterinarian or the judge. Entry fees will not be refund if the show must be canceled or not completed due to acts of nature or emergency situations, including riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of Lakeside ASC .

Lakeside ASC, their Boards of Directors, ASCA, its Board of Directors, and the property owner assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children.
