Please include a copy of ASCA registration papers. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs: or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

**Non-Regular Classes** (Divided by Sex): 2-4 Month Puppy, 4-6 Puppy, BOB Puppy.

**Veterans** (Divided by Sex Intact or Altered): 7-9, 10-12, 13+, Best Veteran

**Regular Altered & Intact** (Divided by Sex): 6-9, 9-12, 12-15, 15-18, Novice, Am. Bred, Bred-By, Open (Divided by Color), Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best of Breed

**Awards:** Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> Place, Rosettes, awards all shows, all days. Great junior prizes!

**\*\*High Point Circuit Champion will be determined as follows: each judge will rank their Best of Breed Intact, Best of Breed Altered, Best of Breed Puppy, and Best Veteran 1st-4th. 1st place receives 4 points, 2nd 3 points, 3rd 2 points, and 4th 1 point. Each set of placements will be placed in a secure envelope and box. Points will be tallied on Sunday. The dog with the highest points will be revealed at the end of the 5th show. Prior to tally one envelope will be pulled and said judges rankings will be used as a tie breaker. \*\***

**Driving Directions from the North:** take I-15 exit 325. Turn right onto Park Lane. Go to the roundabout and take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit (Eastbound Clark Lane). Turn right (South) on to the road between the DMV and Correctional Center. Follow the road past the horse barns and blue buildings. We are in building #3 (South building).
